ICE BREAKER

15 MIN.

CONNECT WITH YOUR GROUP

Have some snacks, welcome and introduce each other, begin with a word of prayer, and then have group members take turns sharing responses to one, two or three of the Ice Breaker questions.



1. What's the weirdest, craziest, or most uncomfortable place you've ever been?
2. Have you ever been "caught red handed" doing something you knew you shouldn't? Who caught you? What happened?
3. Have you ever been tattled on by someone? Why did they do it? How did you react? What was the result?
4. What family rules does your family have that others' don't?

Select one or two members of the group ahead of time to read the passage(s) aloud. Try to use a modern translation like the ESV, NIV, or NLT so everyone can understand.

DISCUSSION TIME

30 MIN.

REVIEW & DISCUSS THE MESSAGE TOGETHER

Have some snacks, welcome and introduce each other, begin with a word of prayer, and then have group members take turns sharing responses to one, two or three of the Ice Breaker questions.



1. What similarities do you see between our world today and what you have learned about ancient Corinth?
2. What was the roughest part of growing up in your home-town?
3. Why is it important that we not jump straight to pointing out people's sins when presenting the gospel?
4. Why is important to know that we have all broken God's law and can never measure up to His standards? (Romans 3:23)
5. Why is it important to know that without God changing our hearts, we will never be able to hear him or turn from our sin? (1 Corinthians 2:14; Ephesians 2:1-3)
6. Have you ever jumped into accusing someone before getting to know them or asking God to help you love them? What happened?
7. In what ways have you heard the gospel shared the wrong way?
8. What does it mean that the Gospel is our source of hope and joy?
9. Why didn't Jesus throw the stone at the woman caught in adultery?
10. In light of how Jesus treated sinners, how should we treat them?



CARING TIME

15 MIN.

APPLY THE LESSON AND PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER

Ask group members if they would like to share responses to these questions. No pressure. Then take turns sharing prayer requests and close in a time of prayer.



1. Is there anything you need to change in your life because of what you've learned this week?
2. Is there anyone you need to ask forgiveness of because you have treated them harshly or shared the gospel with them in a wrong way?
3. In what ways can you prepare for the sermon on 1 Corinthians 5?
